YOUR PRIVACY

Federal and state laws protect the privacy of people who apply for or receive health care coverage, nutrition, economic support, or other public benefits. L.A. County will take the necessary steps to protect the confidential personal information of its residents and will not release your information to immigration officials, unless it is required by law.

YOUR RIGHT TO SERVICES

L.A. County is committed to the well-being and safety of all of its residents, and to ensuring access to County programs and services in an inclusive and secure environment, without fear or intimidation.

YOUR IMMIGRATION STATUS

The County provides services to all residents, regardless of immigration status. You may be eligible for the County's health services, nutrition benefits, housing programs, or other vital services. If you have questions about these services and your immigration status, you should consult with an immigration attorney. The **L.A.
